

Creighton University Presidential, Scott & G. Robert Muchemore Scholarship Application

The top 10% of our applicant pool are invited to apply for these scholarships. Typically students who are very involved in community service, leadership, and school activities complemented by a minimum GPA of a 3.9 on a 4.0 scale (which usually places the student in the Top 5% of their high school) and a 32 ACT (1410 SAT without writing) are invited to apply. About 20% of the students invited to apply ultimately are selected. Students selected for these awards represent the Top 3% of the enrolled class. This scholarship application and supplemental materials must be submitted to the Creighton Admissions Office no later than February 2, 2009.

- **Presidential Scholarships:** Three-quarter tuition renewable scholarships plus \$1,000 room grants are awarded to selected applicants who are in the top 10% of our applicant pool based upon academic record, which indicates curriculum, grades, test scores and leadership abilities. In order to compete, qualified applicants must submit an Application for Admissions and Scholarship by January 6, 2009 including all supporting credentials.
- **Scott Scholarships:** Full tuition renewable scholarships are available to incoming freshmen enrolling in the College of Business Administration. Students who are in the top 10% of our applicant pool based on academic record, which indicates curriculum, grades, test scores and leadership abilities are invited to apply. Qualified applicants must submit an Application for Admission and Scholarship by January 6, 2009 including all supporting credentials.
- **G. Robert Muchemore Foundation Undergraduate Scholarships:** Full tuition award funded by the G. Robert Muchemore Foundation is available to graduates of Nebraska high schools entering as freshmen to Creighton's undergraduate divisions. Selection for this award is highly competitive and based upon high school academic record, which indicates curriculum and ACT or SAT scores, and financial need. Students must file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) as soon as possible after January 1, 2009, to be eligible for this scholarship. Qualified applicants must submit an Application for Admission and Scholarship by January 6, 2009 including all supporting credentials.

The deadline for completed supplemental scholarship applications is February 2, 2009. A complete application will include a finished application form and essays.

Scholarship award recipients will be notified between March 1 and March 15.
