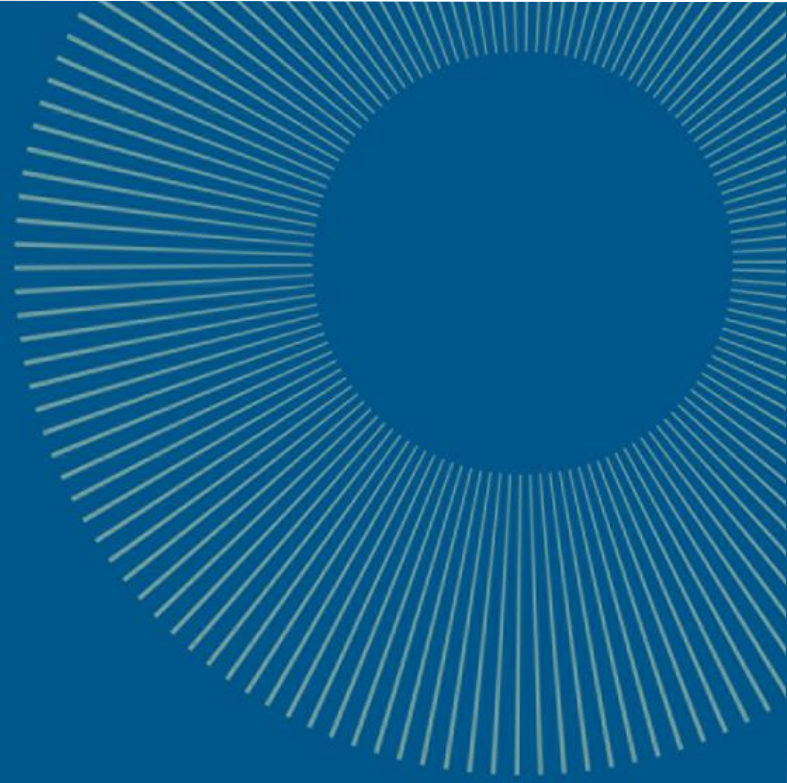



What are supplemental scholarships?

Specific scholarships that students may be eligible for based on their intended major, background, or other criteria. This eligibility is specified by the donor of the scholarship fund.



How do I know if I'm eligible?

You will be able to see everything you are eligible to apply for in your online student portal (choose.creighton.edu/apply/status).

Only about 20% of students are eligible to apply for supplemental scholarships. Most of our students receive most of their merit-based aid from the scholarships that are awarded at the time of admission.



Scott Scholars Scholarship



Qualified candidates meet these criteria:

- Heider College of Business student
- 3.9 GPA
- 32 ACT / 1450 SAT
- Commitment to service & excellence in leadership

How to apply:

- Complete the application in the online student portal by January 5
- Attend the on-campus event (January 28) or complete a Skype interview (January 21-25) and submit Ethics Presentation by January 24

strongly encouraged to attend the on-campus event

Award amount:

Full tuition (replaces general merit scholarship)



Scott Fellows Scholarship

Qualified candidates meet these criteria:

- Heider College of Business student
- Reside outside of Nebraska
- 3.9 GPA
- 32 ACT / 1450 SAT
- Commitment to service & excellence in leadership

How to apply:

- Complete the application in the online student portal by January 5
- Attend the on-campus event (January 28) or complete a Skype interview (January 21-25) and submit Ethics Presentation by January 24

strongly encouraged to attend the on-campus event

- Award amount:

\$10,000 (stackable with general merit scholarship)



G. Robert Muchemore Scholarship

Qualified candidates meet these criteria:

- Graduate of a Nebraska high school
- 3.9 GPA
- 33 ACT / 1490 SAT
- Commitment to service & excellence in leadership

How to apply:

- No application necessary
- File the FAFSA by January 15

Award amount:

\$26,000 (replaces general merit scholarship)



Markoe First Generation Scholarship

Qualified candidates meet these criteria:

- 3.3 GPA
- Students who show a strong & continuous commitment to diversity through extracurricular activities & leadership
- First generation college student (neither parent has a bachelor's degree)
- High financial need (Pell grant eligible)

How to apply:

- Opt into consideration in the online student portal by January 5
- File the FAFSA by January 15

Award amount:

\$30,000 (replaces general merit scholarship)



Native American Merit Scholarship

Qualified candidates meet these criteria:

- Proof of tribal enrollment
- 3.3 GPA
- Students who show a strong & continuous commitment to diversity through extracurricular activities & leadership
- First generation college student (neither parent has a bachelor's degree)
- High financial need (Pell grant eligible)

How to apply:

- Opt into consideration in the online student portal by January 5
- File the FAFSA by January 15

Award amount:

\$30,000 (replaces general merit scholarship)



Ashton Welch History Fellows Scholarship



Qualified candidates meet these criteria:

- College of Arts & Sciences student
- An interest in majoring in history

How to apply:

- Complete the application in the online student portal by January 5
- Attend the on-campus interview day (January 28) or complete a phone interview (January 15-26)

strongly encouraged to attend the on-campus interview

Award amount:

\$2,500 (stackable with general merit scholarship)



Leo Vincent Jacks Scholarship in Classical Languages

Qualified candidates meet these criteria:

- An interest in majoring in classical languages

How to apply:

- No application required (other than noting an interest in classical studies on your admissions application)

Award amount:

\$2,000 (stackable with general merit scholarship)



Grace Keenan Scholarship for Excellence in the Arts

Qualified candidates meet these criteria:

- An interest in a major or minor in art, dance, music, musical theatre, or theatre

How to apply:

- Complete the application in the online student portal by January 5
- Attend the on-campus audition day (January 28) or submit virtually (January 5)

strongly encouraged to attend the on-campus audition

Award amount:

\$4,000 (stackable with general merit scholarship)



Heider College of Business Ethics & Social Responsibility Scholarship

Qualified candidates meet these criteria:

- Heider College of Business student
- 3.6 GPA
- 26 ACT / 1240 SAT
- Commitment to service & excellence in leadership

How to apply:

- Complete the application in the online student portal by January 5
- Attend the on-campus event (January 28) or submit Ethics Presentation by January 24

strongly encouraged to attend the on-campus event

Award amount:

\$2,500 (stackable with general merit scholarship)



Christina M. Hixson Scholarship

Qualified candidates meet these criteria:

- Heider College of Business student
- 3.0 GPA
- Graduate of a CO, IA, IL, KS, MN, MO, NE, ND, SD, WI, or WY high school
- Financial need
- Commitment to service & excellence in leadership

How to apply:

- Complete the application in the online student portal by January 5
- Attend the on-campus competition day (January 28) or submit Ethics Presentation by January 24

strongly encouraged to attend the on-campus event

- File FAFSA by January 15

Award amount:

\$5,000 (stackable with merit scholarship)



Jesuit High School Recognition Awards

Qualified candidates meet these criteria:

- Attend a Jesuit high school

How to apply:

- No application necessary

Award amount:

\$1,000 (awarded at time of admission, along with general merit scholarship)



National Merit Scholarships

Qualified candidates meet these criteria:

- National Merit Finalist
- Select Creighton as your first-choice school

How to apply:

- No application other than the selection of Creighton as your top choice

Award amount:

\$1,000 (stackable with merit scholarship)





Special Programs



Heider Fellows Program

Two main tracks:

- Dean's Fellows
- Business Research Fellows

Qualified candidates typically meet these criteria:

- Heider College of Business student
- 3.7 GPA
- 27 ACT / 1280 SAT

How to apply:

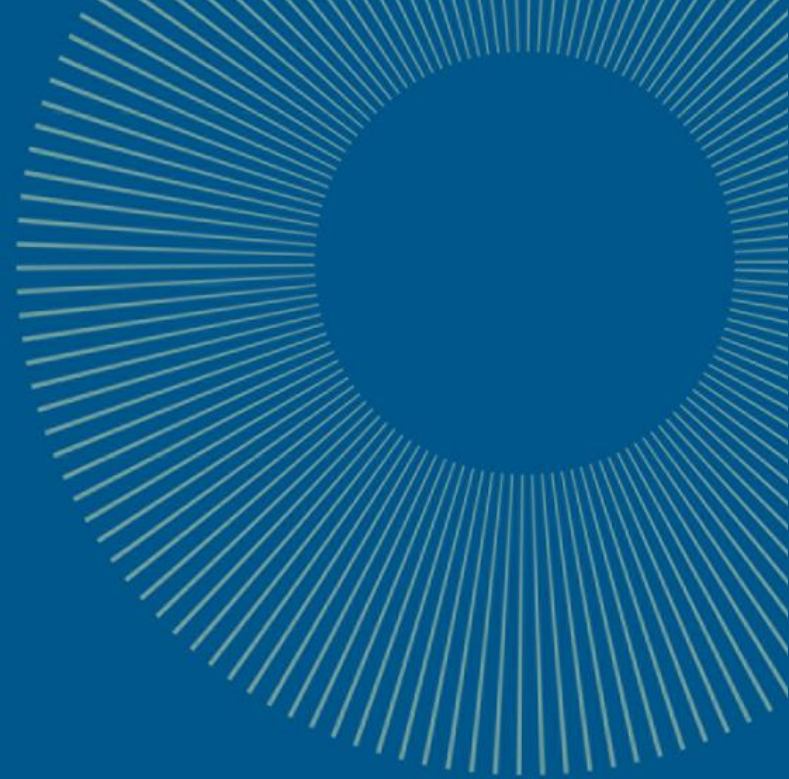
- Complete the application in the online student portal by January 5
- Attend the on-campus event (January 28) or do a Skype interview (January 21-25)

and submit Ethics Presentation by January 24

strongly encouraged to attend the on-campus event

Living requirements: none

Program length: four years



Arts & Sciences Dean's Fellows Program

Qualified candidates meet these criteria:

- Arts & Sciences student
- 3.7 GPA
- 27 ACT / 1280 SAT

How to apply:

- Complete the application in the online student portal by January 5
- Attend the interview weekend (January 28) or do a phone interview (January 15-26)
strongly encouraged to attend the on-campus interview

Living requirements: none

Program length: four years



Honors Program

Qualified candidates meet these criteria:

- Arts & Sciences student
- 3.7 GPA
- 29 ACT / 1350 SAT

How to apply:

- Complete the application in the online student portal by January 5
- Attend the interview weekend (January 28) or do a phone interview (January 15-26)
strongly encouraged to attend the on-campus interview

Living requirements: freshman year only (Swanson)

Program length: four years



Freshman Leadership Program



Qualified candidates meet these criteria:

- Students who are open and willing to explore, engage, learn, and develop their leadership capabilities

How to apply:

- Complete the application in the online student portal by January 5

Living requirements: freshman year (Kiewit)

Program length: one year (but opportunities to be involved as mentor and executive positions after freshman year)



Global Scholars

This is a program for select high-achieving students who are interested in becoming well-rounded, educated global citizens.

4 year program designed to engage students in global problems and solutions, while developing a unique lens through which to enhance their major/minor studies at Creighton

Program highlights:

1st semester Freshman year: Sydney, Australia

1st/2nd semester Sophomore year: Santiago, Dominican Republic

Two international summer experiences

How to apply:

- Apply by January 5
- Complete an in-person (January 28) or phone interview (week of January 22)
- Program fee: \$7,500 a year, plus tuition, fees, room and board

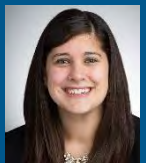
